### COOKIE POLICY

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. These essential cookies are always enabled because our website won't work properly without them. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services. You can switch off these cookies in your browser settings but you may then not be able to access all or parts of our website.
- **Analytical or performance cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

- Stores the Scheduling client's username, OAuth2 Access Token, and OAuth2 Refresh Token. This cookie is required for functionality of logged-in clients

Commerce-checkout-state

- Stores state of checkout while the visitor is completing their order in PayPal
- sessionStorage

hasCart	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tells Squarespace that the visitor has a cart</li> <li>• Cookie</li> <li>• Two weeks</li> </ul>
Locked	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prevents the password-protected screen from displaying if a visitor enters the correct site-wide password.</li> <li>• Cookie</li> <li>• Session</li> </ul>
orderStatusSessionToken	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Authenticates a visitor who logs into an order status page.</li> <li>• Cookie</li> <li>• One year</li> </ul>
PHPSESSID	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Securely authenticates a visitor during their checkout in Scheduling</li> <li>• Cookie</li> <li>• One month</li> </ul>
RecentRedirect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prevents redirect loops if a site has <a href="#">custom URL redirects</a>. Redirect loops are bad for SEO.</li> </ul>

- Prevents the [announcement bar](#) from displaying if a visitor dismisses it

- Shows when you've already "liked" a blog post
- localStorage
- Persistent

squarespace-popup-overlay

- Prevents the [promotional pop-up](#) from displaying if a visitor dismisses it
- localStorage
- Persistent

squarespace-video-player-options

- Remembers video player selected preferences ( volume, playback speed, and quality) for videos [uploaded directly to Squarespace](#)
- localStorage
- Persistent

ss\_cookieAllowed

- Remembers if a visitor agreed to placing analytics cookies on their browser if a site is restricting the placement of cookies
- Cookie
- 30 days

ss\_sd

- Ensures that visitors on the [Squarespace 5 platform](#) remain authenticated during their sessions
- Cookie
- Session

TZ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enables a Scheduling client's appointments to display correctly based on their time zone preferences.</li> <li>• localStorage</li> <li>• Persistent</li> </ul>
